Levantarse	to get up	Enfriarse	to get cold
Casarse	to get married	Enojarse	to get angry
Enfermarse	to get sick	Ensuciarse	to get dirty
Mejorarse	to get better	Irse	to get going
Divorciarse	to get divorced	Liberarse	to get free
Aburrirse	to get bored	Marearse	to get dizzy
Acostumbrarse	to get used to	Meterse	to get involved
Asustarse	to get scared	Mojarse	to get wet
Cambiarse	to get changed	Organizarse	to get organized
Cansarse	to get tired	Perderse	to get lost
Complicarse	to get complicated	Resfriarse	to get a cold
Danarse	to get hurt	Vestirse	to get dressed
Emborracharse	to get drunk		

In the audio lesson, you'll be using these verbs to talk about yourself in the past.

Me levanté	I got up
Me casé	I got married
Me enfermé	I got sick
Me mejoré	I got better
Me divorcié	I got divorced

You'll also use these verbs to talk to someone else informally in the past.

Te levantaste	You got up
Te casaste	You got married
Te enfermaste	You got sick
Te mejoraste	You got better
Te divorciaste	You got divorced

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
